AN ACT in relation to units of local government.


#### Abstract

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:


Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the Chapter 9 Authorization Act.

Section 5. Purpose. The Congress of the United States has enacted certain laws enabling financially distressed persons to seek and obtain certain relief as set forth in Title 11 of the United States Code. This relief includes certain relief for units of local government and school districts generally set forth under Chapter 9 of that Title 11. It is the public policy of this state to provide for the public health, safety, and welfare, and to provide assistance to units of local government and school districts in the formulation and implementation of proper financial accounting procedures, budgeting, and taxing practices. It is the public policy of this state to support the reorganization of the financial affairs of a unit of local government or a school district of this state under the protection and procedures set forth in Chapter 9 of Title 11 of the United States Code.

Section 10. Authorization. Any unit of local government or school district organized under the laws of this state may, on behalf of itself, institute any appropriate action authorized by any act of the Congress of the United States relating to bankruptcy. Any unit of local government or school district may be a debtor under Chapter 9 of Title 11 of the United States Code.
