AN ACT concerning higher education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

(b) Each community college board shall achieve, on a 16 17 phased-in basis as provided in this subsection (b), a ratio 18 between its full-time faculty members and part-time teachers under which at least 75% of all full-time equivalent teaching 19 20 positions in the community college district are held by full-time faculty members and not more than 25% of all 21 full-time equivalent teaching positions in the community 22 college district are held by part-time teachers; provided 23 24 that this subsection (b) shall not be construed to prohibit 25 job sharing of full-time positions.
