- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,

- 4 Section 5. The Toll Highway Act is amended by changing
- 5 Section 3.1 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 3.1. There is created an advisory committee
- 8 composed of 7 members of the House of Representatives
