- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Public Utilities Act is amended by adding
- 5 Section 13-305 as follows:
- 6 (220 ILCS 5/13-305 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 13-305. Reliability requirements.</u>
- 8 <u>(a) If a customer of a telecommunications carrier is</u>
- 9 <u>subjected to a continuous service interruption of 24 hours</u>
- or more that results in the inability of the customer to send
- or receive messages by means of the carrier's service, the
- 12 <u>telecommunications carrier must compensate the customers</u>
- 13 <u>affected by that service interruption for all actual damages</u>
- 14 <u>and consequential</u> <u>damages</u> <u>suffered</u> <u>as a result of the</u>
- 15 <u>service interruption</u>. A waiver of the requirements of this
- 16 <u>Section may be granted by the Commission in instances in</u>
- 17 <u>which the telecommunications carrier can show that the</u>
- 18 service interruption was a result of any one or more of the
- 19 <u>following causes:</u>
- 20 (1) Unpreventable damage due to weather events or
- 21 <u>conditions.</u>
- 22 <u>(2) Customer tampering.</u>
- 23 (3) Unpreventable damage due to civil or
- 24 <u>international unrest or animals.</u>

- 28 (b) Loss of revenue and expenses incurred in complying
- 29 <u>with this Section may not be recovered from ratepayers.</u>
