- 1 AN ACT in relation to public employee benefits.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by
- 5 adding Section 17-117.2 as follows:
- 6 (40 ILCS 5/17-117.2 new)
- Sec. 17-117.2. Nonduty temporary disability benefit.
- 8 <u>(a) A nonduty temporary disability benefit is payable</u>
- 9 <u>only to a member who is in active service on or after June</u>
- 10 <u>30, 2002 and has at least 3 years of creditable service.</u>
- 11 The benefit is payable upon application of a member who
- 12 <u>is not receiving a benefit under Section 17-116, 17-117,</u>
- 13 <u>17-117.1</u>, or 17-117.3. The benefit shall be granted only if
- 14 the member is found by medical examination to be
- incapacitated to perform the duties of his or her position as
- 16 <u>a teacher and only if the commencement of the incapacity</u>
- occurred while the member was employed as a teacher or within
- 18 <u>90 days of such employment.</u>
- 19 <u>A member shall be considered disabled only when the Fund</u>
- 20 <u>has received (1) a written certificate by at least 2 licensed</u>
- 21 and practicing physicians designated by the Fund, certifying
- 22 <u>that the member is disabled and unable to properly perform</u>
- 23 the duties of his or her position at the time of disability,
- 24 <u>except in the case of disability due to pregnancy where a</u>
- 25 <u>written certificate from only one licensed and practicing</u>
- 26 physician is required; (2) a written statement from the
- 27 Employer certifying that the member is not eligible to
- 28 <u>receive a salary; and (3) a certification from the member</u>
- 29 <u>that he or she is not and has not been engaged in gainful</u>
- 30 <u>employment during the period of disability.</u>
- 31 The benefit shall begin to accrue on the 31st day of

- 1 <u>absence from service on account of disability, except that</u>
- 2 when an application is made more than 90 days subsequent to
- 3 the later of the commencement of disability or the date
- 4 eligibility for salary ceases, it shall begin to accrue from
- 5 the date of application, and shall be payable during the time
- 6 the member does not receive a retirement annuity. The
- 7 <u>benefit</u> is not payable to a member who is receiving or has a
- 8 right to receive any salary as a teacher, or is employed in
- 9 any capacity as a teacher by the employers included under
- 10 this Fund or in an equivalent capacity in any other public or
- 11 private school, college or university.
- 12 <u>Service credits under the State Employees' Retirement</u>
- 13 System of Illinois, the State Universities Retirement System,
- 14 <u>the Teachers' Retirement System of the State of Illinois, and</u>
- the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund shall be considered in
- 16 <u>determining the member's eligibility for a disability benefit</u>
- 17 and the total period during which the disability benefit is
- 18 payable.
- 19 <u>(b) The nonduty temporary disability benefit shall be</u>
- 20 <u>40% of the greater of the member's most recent annual</u>
- 21 <u>contract salary rate at the time the disability benefit</u>
- 22 <u>becomes payable or the member's annual contract rate on the</u>
- 23 <u>date the disability commenced.</u>
- In addition to the above benefit, the member shall
- 25 receive creditable service and credit for contributions that
- 26 the member would have made in active employment during any
- 27 period of disability for which benefits are paid by the Fund
- on the basis of the annual salary rate used in computing the
- 29 <u>benefit</u>.
- 30 (c) The nonduty temporary disability benefit shall
- 31 <u>continue until the first of the following events occurs: (1)</u>
- 32 <u>disability ceases; (2) the member requests termination of the</u>
- 33 <u>benefit; (3) the aggregate period for which disability</u>
- 34 payments made during the member's entire period of service

- 1 equals 1/4 of the total period of creditable service, not
- 2 <u>including the time he or she has received the disability</u>
- 3 payments; or (4) the member is engaged or found to be able to
- 4 <u>engage in gainful employment. If the disability benefit is</u>
- 5 <u>discontinued under item (4) but the member is subsequently</u>
- 6 found to be unable to be gainfully employed due to the
- 7 <u>disability that was the cause for his or her most recent</u>
- 8 <u>incapacity to perform the duties of a teacher, the disability</u>
- 9 <u>benefit</u> shall be resumed, upon notification of the Fund, as
- 10 soon as the member is not eligible to receive salary.
- 11 <u>A disabled member who receives a nonduty temporary</u>
- 12 <u>disability benefit for the maximum period specified above or</u>
- 13 who requests that the disability benefits be terminated may
- be retired on a disability retirement pension.
- 15 (d) The board shall prescribe rules governing the
- filing, investigation, control, and supervision of disability
- 17 <u>claims</u>. The rules shall include specific standards to be
- 18 <u>used when requesting additional medical examinations</u>,
- 19 <u>hospital records</u>, or other data necessary for determining the
- 20 <u>employment capacity and condition of the member. Costs</u>
- 21 <u>incurred by a claimant in connection with completing a claim</u>
- for disability benefits shall be paid by the claimant.
- 23 Section 90. The State Mandates Act is amended by adding
- 24 Section 8.25 as follows:
- 25 (30 ILCS 805/8.25 new)
- 26 <u>Sec. 8.25. Exempt mandate. Notwithstanding Sections 6</u>
- 27 and 8 of this Act, no reimbursement by the State is required
- 28 for the implementation of any mandate created by this
- 29 <u>amendatory Act of the 92nd General Assembly.</u>
- 30 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 31 becoming law.
