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1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 2729

2 AMENDMENT NO. ____. Amend House Bill 2729 by replacing 3 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the 4 following:

5 "Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing6 Section 25-11 as follows:

7 (10 ILCS 5/25-11) (from Ch. 46, par. 25-11)

Sec. 25-11. When a vacancy occurs in any elective county 8 9 office, or in a county of less than 3,000,000 population in the office of clerk of the circuit court, in a county which 10 is not a home rule unit, the county board or board of county 11 commissioners shall declare that such vacancy exists and 12 notification thereof shall be given to the county central 13 14 committee or the appropriate county board or board of county 15 commissioners district committee of each established political party within 3 days of the occurrence of the 16 vacancy. The vacancy shall be filled within 60 days by 17 appointment of the chairman of the county board or board of 18 county commissioners with the advice and consent of the 19 county board or board of county commissioners. In counties in 20 21 which forest preserve district commissioners are elected by 22 districts and are not also members of the county board,

1 however, vacancies in the office of forest preserve district commissioner shall be filled within 60 days by appointment of 2 the president of the forest preserve district board of 3 4 commissioners with the advice and consent of the forest preserve district board of commissioners. In counties in 5 6 which the forest preserve district president is not also a 7 member the county board, vacancies in the office of forest preserve district president shall be filled within 60 days by 8 9 the forest preserve district board of commissioners by appointing one of the commissioners to serve as president. 10 11 The appointee shall be a member of the same political party as the person he succeeds was at the time of his election and 12 shall be otherwise eligible to serve. The appointee shall 13 serve the remainder of the unexpired term. However, if more 14 15 than 28 months remain in the term, the appointment shall be 16 until the next general election at which time the vacated office shall be filled by election for the remainder of the 17 In the case of a vacancy in a seat on a county board 18 term. 19 or board of county commissioners which has been divided into districts under Section 2-3003 or 2-4006.5 of the Counties 20 Code, the appointee must also be a resident of the county 21 board or county commission district. If a county commissioner 22 23 ceases to reside in the district that he or she represents, a vacancy in that office exists. 24

Except as otherwise provided by county ordinance or by law, in any county which is a home rule unit, vacancies in elective county offices, other than the office of chief executive officer, and vacancies in the office of clerk of the circuit court in a county of less than 3,000,000 population, shall be filled by the county board or board of county commissioners.

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Section 10. The Downstate Forest Preserve District Act

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1 is amended by changing Section 3c as follows:

2 (70 ILCS 805/3c)

3 Sec. 3c. Elected board of commissioners in certain counties. If the boundaries of a district are co-extensive 4 5 with the boundaries of a county having a population of more than 800,000 but less than 3,000,000, all commissioners of 6 the forest preserve district shall be elected from the 7 same districts as members of the county board beginning with the 8 general election held in 2002 and each succeeding general 9 10 election. One commissioner shall be elected from each 11 district. At their first meeting after their election in 2002 and following each subsequent decennial reapportionment 12 of the county under Division 2-3 of the Counties Code, the 13 14 elected commissioners shall publicly by lot divide themselves 15 into 2 groups, as equal in size as possible. Commissioners from the first group shall serve for terms of 2, 4, and 4 16 17 years; and commissioners from the second group shall serve terms of 4, 4, and 2 years. Commissioners-elected-under-this 18 Section---shall---take---office---at--the--first--meeting--of 19 commissioners--following--an---election---of---commissioners. 20 21 Beginning with the general election in 2002, the president of 22 the board of commissioners of the forest preserve district shall be elected by the voters of the county, rather than by 23 24 the commissioners. The president shall be <u>a resident of the</u> 25 county and shall be elected throughout the county for a 26 4-year term without having been first elected as commissioner of the forest preserve district. The term of office for the 27 28 president and commissioners elected under this Section shall commence on the first Monday of the month following the month 29 of election. Neither a commissioner nor the president of the 30 board of commissioners of that forest preserve district shall 31 serve simultaneously as member or chairman of the county 32 33 board. No person shall seek election to both the forest

1 preserve commission and the county board at the same 2 election. The compensation for the president shall be an amount equal to 85% of the annual salary of the county board 3 4 The president, with the advice and consent of the chairman. 5 board of commissioners shall appoint a secretary, treasurer, 6 and such other officers as deemed necessary by the board of commissioners, which officers need not be members of the 7 board of commissioners. The president shall have the powers 8 9 and duties as specified in Section 12 of this Act.

10 Candidates for <u>president and</u> commissioner shall be 11 candidates of established political parties.

12 If a vacancy in the office of president or commissioner 13 occurs, other than by expiration of the president's or a commissioner's term, the forest preserve district board of 14 commissioners shall declare that a vacancy exists and 15 notification of the vacancy shall be given to the county 16 central committee of each established political party within 17 3 business days after the occurrence of the vacancy. If the 18 19 vacancy occurs in the office of forest preserve district commissioner, the president of the board of commissioners 20 21 shall, within 60 days after the date of the vacancy, with the 22 advice and consent of other commissioners then serving, 23 appoint <u>a person</u> an-individual to serve for the remainder of the unexpired term. The appointee shall be affiliated with 24 25 the same political party as the commissioner in whose office the vacancy occurred and be a resident of such district. 26 Τf a vacancy in the office of president occurs, other than by 27 expiration of the president's term, the remaining members of 28 29 the board of commissioners shall, within 60 days after the 30 vacancy, appoint one of the commissioners to serve as president for the remainder of the unexpired term. In that 31 32 case, the office of the commissioner who is appointed to 33 serve as president shall be deemed vacant and shall be filled within 60 days by appointment of the president with the 34

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1 advice and consent of the other forest preserve district commissioners. The commissioner who is appointed to fill a 2 vacancy in the office of president shall be affiliated with 3 4 the same political party as the person who occupied the office of president prior to the vacancy. A person appointed 5 to fill a vacancy in the office of president or commissioner 6 7 shall establish his or her party affiliation by his or her 8 record of voting in primary elections or by holding or having 9 held an office in an established political party organization before the appointment. If the appointee has not voted in a 10 11 party primary election or is not holding or has not held an 12 office in an established political party organization before the appointment, the appointee shall establish his or her 13 political party affiliation by his or her record of 14 participating in an established political party's nomination 15 16 or election caucus. If, however, more than 28 months remain in the unexpired term of a commissioner or the president, the 17 appointment shall be until the next general eenselidated 18 election, at which time the vacated office of commissioner or 19 president shall be filled by election for the remainder of 20 the term. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, if a 21 22 vacancy occurs after the last day provided in Section 7-12 of the Election Code for filing nomination papers for the office 23 24 of president of a forest preserve district where that office is elected as provided for in this Section, or as set forth 25 in Section 7-61 of the Election Code, a vacancy in nomination 26 shall be filled by the passage of a resolution by the 27 nominating committee of the affected political party within 28 the time periods specified in the Election Code. The 29 nominating committee shall consist of the chairman of the 30 31 county central committee and the township chairmen of the affected political party. All other vacancies in nomination 32 shall be filled in accordance with the provisions of the 33 34 Election Code.

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1 The president and commissioners elected under this 2 Section may be reimbursed for their reasonable expenses 3 actually incurred in performing their official duties under 4 this Act in accordance with the provisions of Section 3a. 5 The reimbursement paid under this Section shall be paid by 6 the forest preserve district.

7 Compensation for forest preserve commissioners elected 8 under this Section shall be the same as that of county board 9 members of the county with which the forest preserve 10 district's boundaries are co-extensive.
