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AN ACT in relation to taxation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Sec. 22-9. Power to make grants from the Illinois 7 8 Military Family Relief Fund. Subject to appropriation, the 9 Department of Military Affairs shall have the power to make grants from the Illinois Military Family Relief Fund, a 10 special fund created in the State treasury, to families of 11 persons who are members of the Illinois National Guard or 12 13 Illinois residents who are members of the reserves of the armed forces of the United States and who have been called to 14 15 active duty as a result of the September 11, 2001 terrorist attacks. The Department of Military Affairs shall establish 16 eligibility criteria for the grants by rule. 17

Section 10. The State Finance Act is amended by addingSection 5.570 as follows:

1 2002, the Department shall print on its standard individual 2 income tax form a provision indicating that if the taxpayer wishes to contribute to the Illinois Military Family Relief 3 4 Fund, as authorized by this amendatory Act of the 92nd 5 General Assembly, he or she may do so by stating the amount of the contribution (not less than \$1) on the return and that 6 the contribution will reduce the taxpayer's refund or 7 8 increase the amount of payment to accompany the return. Failure to remit any amount of increased payment shall reduce 9 the contribution accordingly. This Section shall not apply to 10 11 any amended return.
