- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Sale of Tobacco to Minors Act is amended
- 5 by changing Section 1 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 675/1) (from Ch. 23, par. 2357)
- 7 Sec. 1. (a) No minor under 18 years of age shall buy any
- 8 cigar, cigarette, smokeless tobacco or tobacco in any of its

- 10 (b) No person shall sell, buy for, distribute samples of
- or furnish any cigar, cigarette, smokeless tobacco or tobacco
