Section 4. The sum of \$8,000,000, or so much thereof as 2 3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation Regulatory Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for 4 5 disbursing funds collected for the Single State Insurance Registration Program to be distributed to: (1) participating 6 7 states, provided that no distributions exceed funds made 8 available from registration collections; and (2) for refunds 9 for overpayments.

- Section 5. The sum of \$750,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation Regulatory Fund to assist the Illinois Commerce Commission in monitoring railroad crossing safety.
- Section 6. The sum of \$1,360,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Public Utility

 Fund to assist the Illinois Commerce Commission in implementing the Electric Service Customer Choice and Rate

 Relief Law of 1997.
- Section 7. The sum of \$584,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to assist the Illinois Commerce Commission in implementing the Electric Service Customer Choice and Rate Relief Law of 1997, including costs in prior years.
- Section 8. The sum of \$833,200, or so much thereof as
 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 Fund to assist the Illinois Commerce Commission in
 implementing a consumer education program regarding the
 Electric Service Customer Choice and Rate Relief Law of 1997.

- 1 Section 9. The sum of \$475,000, or so much thereof as
