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AN ACT relating to schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing
Sections 10-20.7b and 34-15a as follows:

б (105 ILCS 5/10-20.7b) (from Ch. 122, par. 10-20.7b) 10-20.7b. Active military 7 Sec. service. Any 8 certificated or non-certificated employee of a school board who is a member of any reserve component of the United States 9 Armed Services, including the Illinois National Guard, and 10 who is mobilized to active military duty on or after August 11 1, 1990 as-a-result-of-an--order--of--the--President--of--the 12 13 United--States, shall for each pay period beginning on or after August 1, 1990 continue to receive the same regular 14 15 compensation that he receives or was receiving as an employee 16 of the school board at the time he is or was so mobilized to active military duty, plus any health insurance and other 17 18 benefits he is or was receiving or accruing at that time, 19 minus the amount of his base pay for military service, for 20 the duration of his active military service. Such active 21 military duty shall not result in the loss or diminishment of 22 any employment benefit, service credit, or status accrued at the time the duty commenced if the duty commenced on or after 23 September 1, 2001. 24

In the event any provision of a collective bargaining agreement or any school board or district policy covering any employee so ordered to active duty is more generous than the provisions contained in this Section, the collective bargaining agreement or school board or district policy shall be controlling.

Any certificated or non-certificated employee of the Board of Education who is 3 4 a member of any reserve component of the United States Armed 5 Services, including the Illinois National Guard, and who is 6 mobilized to active military duty on or after August 1, 1990 7 as-a-result-of-an--order--of--the--President--of--the--United 8 States, shall for each pay period beginning on or after 9 August 1, 1990 continue to receive the same regular compensation that he receives or was receiving as an employee 10 11 of the Board of Education at the time he is or was so mobilized to active military duty, plus any health insurance 12 and other benefits he is or was receiving or accruing at that 13 time, minus the amount of his base pay for military service, 14 for the duration of his active military service. Such active 15 16 military duty shall not result in the loss or diminishment of 17 any employment benefit, service credit, or status accrued at 18 the time the duty commenced if the duty commenced on or after 19 September 1, 2001.

In the event any provision of a collective bargaining 20 agreement or any board of education or district policy 21 22 covering any employee so ordered to active duty is more 23 generous than the provisions contained in this Section, the collective bargaining agreement or board of education or 24 25 district policy shall be controlling.
