- 7 <u>Sec. 2-3.131. K-3 class size reduction grant program. A</u>
- 8 class size reduction grant program is hereby created. The
- 9 program shall be implemented and administered by the State

- 12 <u>districts</u> that meet the criteria established by this Section
- for the award of those grants.
- 14 Grants shall be awarded pursuant to application. The

- 7 and expenses of operating and maintaining classes with a
- 8 <u>class size of no more than 20 pupils in kindergarten for the</u>
- 9 <u>2003-2004</u> school year, in kindergarten and first grade for
- 10 the 2004-2005 school year, in kindergarten and first and
