AN ACT in relation to public aid.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by
changing Section 3-2 as follows:

6 (305 ILCS 5/3-2) (from Ch. 23, par. 3-2)

Sec. 3-2. Conditions for basic maintenance grants to 7 persons receiving institutional care. A resident of a 8 public or private home or institution maintained for the care 9 of persons who are sick, convalescent, infirm or chronically 10 ill, may, if otherwise qualified, be granted financial aid 11 for basic maintenance, subject to the rules and regulations 12 13 of the Illinois Department, if the facilities of the home or institution are in conformity with standards prescribed by 14 the Department of Public Health for safeguarding the health, 15 16 safety, and comfort of the residents of the home or institution thereof, and provide such services as may be 17 prescribed by the Illinois Department for enhancing their 18 rehabilitation or increasing their capacity for self-care. 19 (Source: Laws 1967, p. 122.) 20
