AN ACT concerning the regulation of professions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Dietetic and Nutrition Services Practice
Act is amended by changing Section 15.5 as follows:

8 Sec. 15.5. Unlicensed practice; violation; civil
9 penalty.

(a) Any person who practices, offers to practice, 10 attempts to practice, or holds oneself out to practice 11 dietetics or nutrition counseling without being 12 licensed under this Act shall, in addition to any other penalty 13 provided by law, pay a civil penalty to the Department in an 14 amount not to exceed \$5,000 for each offense as determined by 15 16 the Department. The civil penalty shall be assessed by the Department after a hearing is held in accordance with the 17 18 provisions set forth in this Act regarding the provision of a hearing for the discipline of a licensee. 19

20 (b) The Department has the authority and power to21 investigate any and-all unlicensed activity.

(c) The civil penalty shall be paid within 60 days after the effective date of the order imposing the civil penalty. The order shall constitute a judgment and may be filed and execution had thereon in the same manner as any judgment from any court of record.
