1 AN ACT in relation to vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 3. The State Finance Act is amended by adding
Section 5.570 as follows:

6 (30 ILCS 105/5.570 new)
7 <u>Sec. 5.570. The Professional Sports Teams Education</u>
8 <u>Fund.</u>

9 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by 10 changing Sections 3-621, 3-622, 3-623, 3-625, and 3-806.3 and 11 renumbering Sections 3-648 as added by Public Act 92-79 and 12 3-648 as added by Public Act 92-467 and by adding Section 13 3-654 as follows:

14 (625 ILCS 5/3-621) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-621)

Sec. 3-621. The Secretary, upon receipt of 15 an 16 application, made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may issue to members of the Illinois National Guard, 17 18 and to Illinois residents who are either former members of the Illinois National Guard or the surviving spouses of 19 20 Illinois National Guard members, special registration plates. The special plates issued pursuant to this Section shall be 21 affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division or 22 23 motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 24 8,000 pounds subject to the staggered registration system.

25 The design and color of such plates shall be wholly 26 within the discretion of the Secretary of State. 27 (Source: P.A. 84-986.)

1 Sec. 3-622. The Secretary, upon receipt of an 2 application made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may issue to members of the United States Armed Forces 3 4 Reserves who reside in Illinois, and to Illinois residents 5 who are either former members of the United States Armed Forces Reserves or the surviving spouses of United States б 7 Armed Forces Reserve members who resided in Illinois, special registration plates. The special plates issued pursuant to 8 9 this Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division or motor vehicles of the second division 10 11 weighing not more than 8,000 pounds subject to the staggered registration system. The design and color of such plates 12 shall be wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of 13 14 State.

(625 ILCS 5/3-623) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-623) 16 17 Sec. 3-623. Purple Heart Plates. The Secretary, upon receipt of an application made in the form prescribed by the 18 Secretary of State, may issue to recipients awarded the 19 20 Purple Heart by a branch of the armed forces of the United States who reside in Illinois, special registration plates. 21 22 The special plates issued pursuant to this Section should be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the 1st division, 23 24 including motorcycles, or motor vehicles of the 2nd division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. 25

The design and color of such plates shall be wholly 26 within the discretion of the Secretary of State. Appropriate 27 documentation, as determined by the Secretary, and the 28 29 appropriate standard registration fee shall accompany the application. However, for an individual who has been issued 30 31 Purple Heart plates for a vehicle and who has claimed and received a grant under the Senior Citizens and Disabled 32 33 Persons Property Tax Relief and Pharmaceutical Assistance

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Act, the original-issuance-fee-and-regular annual fee for the
 registration of the vehicle shall be as provided in Section
 3-806.3 of this Code.

б Sec. 3-625. Pearl Harbor Plates. The Secretary, upon 7 receipt of an application made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may issue special registration plates to 8 any Illinois resident who, while a member of the armed forces 9 10 of the United States, participated in the battle of Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941, or to the widowed spouse of any 11 Illinois resident who, while a member of the armed forces of 12 the United States, participated in the battle of Pearl Harbor 13 14 on December 7, 1941, provided that the widowed spouse was 15 married to the battle of Pearl Harbor participant at the time of the participant's death and is a single person at the time 16 17 of application. The special plates issued pursuant to this 18 Section should be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the 1st division or motor vehicles of the 2nd division weighing 19 20 not more than 8,000 pounds.

The design and color of such plates shall be wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State. Appropriate documentation, as determined by the Secretary, and the <u>appropriate</u> standard registration fee shall accompany the application.

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Sec. <u>3-650.</u> 3-648. Army Combat Veteran license plates.

(a) In addition to any other special license plate, the
Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and
applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of
State, may issue Army Combat Veteran license plates to

1 residents of Illinois who meet eligibility requirements 2 prescribed by the Secretary of State. The special Army Combat Veteran plate issued under this Section shall be 3 4 affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division and motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 5 б 8,000 pounds. Plates issued under this Section shall expire 7 according to the staggered multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code. 8

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9 The plates shall display the Army Combat Infantry (b) In all other respects, the design, color, and format 10 Badge. 11 of the plates shall be within the discretion of the Secretary of State. The Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow 12 the plates to be issued as vanity plates or personalized in 13 accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are 14 not required to designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in 15 16 subsection (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe the eligibility requirements and, in his or 17 her discretion, shall approve and prescribe stickers or 18 19 decals as provided under Section 3-412.

(c) An applicant shall be charged a \$15 fee for original 20 21 issuance in addition to the applicable registration fee. This additional fee shall be deposited into the Secretary of 22 23 State Special License Plate Fund. For each registration renewal period, a \$2 fee, in addition to the appropriate 24 25 registration fee, shall be charged and shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund. 26 (Source: P.A. 92-79, eff. 1-1-02; revised 10-17-01.) 27

29 Sec. <u>3-651.</u> 3-648- U.S. Marine Corps license plates.

30 (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the
31 Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and
32 applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of
33 State, may issue special registration plates designated as

1 U.S. Marine Corps license plates to residents of Illinois who 2 meet eligibility requirements prescribed by the Secretary of State. The special plate issued under this Section shall be 3 4 affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division, 5 motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds, and recreational vehicles as defined by Section 6 7 1-169 of this Code. Plates issued under this Section shall 8 expire according to the staggered multi-year procedure 9 established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

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(b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be 10 11 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State, 12 except that the U.S. Marine Corps emblem shall appear on the plates. The Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow 13 the plates to be issued as vanity or personalized plates in 14 accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are 15 16 not required to designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary 17 shall prescribe the eligibility requirements and, in his or 18 19 her discretion, shall approve and prescribe stickers or decals as provided under Section 3-412. 20

21 (c) An applicant shall be charged a \$20 fee for original issuance in addition to the applicable registration fee. 22 Of 23 this additional fee, \$15 shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund and \$5 shall be 24 25 deposited into the Marine Corps Scholarship Fund. For each registration renewal period, a \$20 fee, in addition to the 26 appropriate registration fee, shall be charged. Of this 27 additional fee, \$2 shall be deposited into the Secretary of 28 State Special License Plate Fund and \$18 shall be deposited 29 30 into the Marine Corps Scholarship Fund.

31 (d) The Marine Corps Scholarship Fund is created as a
32 special fund in the State treasury. All moneys in the Marine
33 Corps Scholarship Fund shall, subject to appropriation by the
34 General Assembly and approval by the Secretary, be used by

1 the Marine Corps Scholarship Foundation, Inc., a recognized 2 charitable organization that meets the requirements of Title 26, Section 501(c)(3) of the United States Code, to provide 3 4 grants for scholarships for higher education. The scholarship recipients must be the children of current or former members 5 of the United States Marine Corps who meet the academic, 6 7 financial, and other requirements established by the Marine 8 Corps Scholarship Foundation. In addition, the recipients 9 must be Illinois residents and must attend a college or university located within the State of Illinois. 10

11 The State Treasurer shall require the Marine Corps Scholarship Foundation to establish a separate account for 12 receipt of the proceeds of the Marine Corps Scholarship Fund. 13 That account shall be subject to audit either annually or at 14 15 another interval, as determined by the State Treasurer. 16 Proceeds from the Marine Corps Scholarship Fund shall be transferred on a quarterly basis by the State Treasurer's 17 office to this separate account. 18

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(625 ILCS 5/3-654 new)

21 Sec. 3-654. Professional Sports Teams license plates. (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of an application made 22 23 in the form prescribed by the Secretary, may issue special registration plates designated as Professional Sports Teams 24 license plates. The special plates issued under this Section 25 26 shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division and motor vehicles of the second division weighing 27 not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued under this Section 28 shall expire according to the multi-year procedure 29 30 established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

(b) The design and color of the plates is wholly within
 the discretion of the Secretary, except that the plates
 shall, subject to the permission of the applicable team

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1 owner, display the logo of the Chicago Bears, the Chicago
2 Bulls, the Chicago Black Hawks, the Chicago Cubs, the Chicago
3 White Sox, the St. Louis Rams, or the St. Louis Cardinals, at
4 the applicant's option. The Secretary may allow the plates
5 to be issued as vanity or personalized plates under Section
6 3-405.1 of the Code. The Secretary shall prescribe stickers
7 or decals as provided under Section 3-412 of this Code.

8 (c) An applicant for the special plate shall be charged 9 <u>a \$40 fee for original issuance in addition to the</u> 10 <u>appropriate registration fee. Of this fee, \$25 shall be</u> 11 <u>deposited into the Professional Sports Teams Education Fund</u> 12 <u>and \$15 shall be deposited into the Secretary of State</u> 13 <u>Special License Plate Fund, to be used by the Secretary to</u> 14 <u>help defray the administrative processing costs.</u>

For each registration renewal period, a \$27 fee, in addition to the appropriate registration fee, shall be charged. Of this fee, \$25 shall be deposited into the Professional Sports Teams Education Fund and \$2 shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

21 (d) The Professional Sports Teams Education Fund is 22 created as a special fund in the State treasury. All moneys 23 in the Professional Sports Teams Education Fund shall, 24 subject to appropriation by the General Assembly and approval 25 by the Secretary, be deposited every 6 months into the Common 26 School Fund.

29 Commencing--with-the-1986-registration-year-and-extending 30 through-the-2000-registration-year,-the-registration-fee-paid 31 by-any-vehicle-owner-who-has-claimed--and--received--a--grant 32 under--the-"Senior-Citizens-and-Disabled-Persons-Property-Tax 33 Relief-and-Pharmaceutical--Assistance--Act"--or--who--is--the

1 spouse-of-such-a-person-shall-be-reduced-by-50%-for-passenger 2 cars---displaying--standard--multi-year--registration--plates issued--under--Section--3-414.1,--motor--vehicles--displaying 3 4 special-registration-plates-issued-under-Section-3-616,-motor vehicles-registered-at-8,000-pounds--or--less--under--Section 5 3-815(a)-and-recreational-vehicles-registered-at-8,000-pounds 6 7 or--less--under--Section--3-815(b)----Widows--and-widowers-of 8 elaimants-shall-also-be-entitled-to-the-reduced--registration 9 rate--for--the--registration--year--in-which-the-claimant-was 10 eligible.

11 Commencing with the 2001 registration year and extending 12 through the 2003 registration year, the registration fee paid 13 by any vehicle owner who has claimed and received a grant under the "Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons Property Tax 14 15 Relief and Pharmaceutical Assistance Act" or who is the 16 spouse of such a person shall be \$24 instead of the fee otherwise provided in this Code for passenger cars displaying 17 standard multi-year registration plates issued under Section 18 3-414.1, motor vehicles displaying special 19 registration plates issued under Section 3-616, motor vehicles registered 20 21 at 8,000 pounds or less under Section 3-815(a) and 22 recreational vehicles registered at 8,000 pounds or less 23 under Section 3-815(b). Widows and widowers of claimants shall also be entitled to this reduced registration fee for 24 25 the registration year in which the claimant was eligible.

Commencing with the 2004 registration year, the 26 27 registration fee paid by any vehicle owner who has claimed and received a grant under the Senior Citizens and Disabled 28 29 Persons Property Tax Relief and Pharmaceutical Assistance Act or who is the spouse of such a person shall be \$24 instead of 30 31 the fee otherwise provided in this Code for passenger cars displaying standard multi-year registration plates issued 32 under Section 3-414.1, motor vehicles displaying special 33 registration plates issued under Section 3-616, 3-621, 3-622, 34

1 <u>3-623, 3-624, 3-625, 3-626, 3-628, 3-638, 3-642, 3-645,</u> 3 <u>3-647, 3-650, or 3-651, motor vehicles registered at 8,000</u> pounds or less under Section 3-815(a), and recreational vehicles registered at 8,000 pounds or less under Section <u>3-815(b). Widows and widowers of claimants shall also be</u> entitled to this reduced registration fee for the registration year in which the claimant was eligible.

No more than one reduced registration fee under this 8 9 Section shall be allowed during any 12 month period based on the primary eligibility of any individual, whether such 10 reduced registration fee is allowed to the individual or to 11 the spouse, widow or widower of such individual. This 12 Section does not apply to the fee paid in addition to the 13 registration fee for motor vehicles displaying vanity or 14 special personalized license plates under-Section-3-806-1. 15 (Source: P.A. 91-37, eff. 7-1-99; revised 12-06-01.) 16
