1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 4937

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 4937 by replacing 3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by
5 changing Sections 3-623, 3-625, and 3-806.3 and renumbering
6 Sections 3-648 as added by Public Act 92-79 and 3-648 as
7 added by Public Act 92-467 as follows:

8 (625 ILCS 5/3-623) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-623)

9 Sec. 3-623. Purple Heart Plates. The Secretary, upon 10 receipt of an application made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may issue to recipients awarded the 11 Purple Heart by a branch of the armed forces of the United 12 States who reside in Illinois, special registration plates. 13 14 The special plates issued pursuant to this Section should be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the 1st division, 15 including motorcycles, or motor vehicles of the 2nd division 16 weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. 17

18 The design and color of such plates shall be wholly 19 within the discretion of the Secretary of State. Appropriate 20 documentation, as determined by the Secretary, and the 21 <u>appropriate</u> standard registration fee shall accompany the 22 application. However, for an individual who has been issued Purple Heart plates for a vehicle and who has claimed and received a grant under the Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons Property Tax Relief and Pharmaceutical Assistance Act, the original-issuance-fee-and-regular annual fee for the registration of the vehicle shall be as provided in Section 3-806.3 of this Code.

8 (625 ILCS 5/3-625) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-625) Sec. 3-625. Pearl Harbor Plates. The Secretary, upon 9 10 receipt of an application made in the form prescribed by the 11 Secretary of State, may issue special registration plates to any Illinois resident who, while a member of the armed forces 12 of the United States, participated in the battle of Pearl 13 Harbor on December 7, 1941, or to the widowed spouse of any 14 15 Illinois resident who, while a member of the armed forces of the United States, participated in the battle of Pearl Harbor 16 17 on December 7, 1941, provided that the widowed spouse was married to the battle of Pearl Harbor participant at the time 18 19 of the participant's death and is a single person at the time 20 of application. The special plates issued pursuant to this Section should be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the 21 22 1st division or motor vehicles of the 2nd division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. 23

The design and color of such plates shall be wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State. Appropriate documentation, as determined by the Secretary, and the <u>appropriate</u> standard registration fee shall accompany the application.

32 (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the

1 Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and 2 applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may issue Army Combat Veteran license plates to 3 4 residents of Illinois who meet eligibility requirements 5 prescribed by the Secretary of State. The special Army 6 Combat Veteran plate issued under this Section shall be 7 affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division and 8 motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 9 8,000 pounds. Plates issued under this Section shall expire according to the staggered multi-year procedure established 10 11 by Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

(b) The plates shall display the Army Combat Infantry 12 In all other respects, the design, color, and format 13 Badge. of the plates shall be within the discretion of the Secretary 14 The Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow 15 of State. 16 the plates to be issued as vanity plates or personalized in accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are 17 not required to designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in 18 19 subsection (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe the eligibility requirements and, in his or 20 21 her discretion, shall approve and prescribe stickers or decals as provided under Section 3-412. 22

23 (c) An applicant shall be charged a \$15 fee for original issuance in addition to the applicable registration fee. 24 25 This additional fee shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund. 33 (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the

1 Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and 2 applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of may issue special registration plates designated as 3 State, 4 U.S. Marine Corps license plates to residents of Illinois who 5 meet eligibility requirements prescribed by the Secretary of 6 State. The special plate issued under this Section shall be 7 affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division, motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8 9 8,000 pounds, and recreational vehicles as defined by Section 1-169 of this Code. Plates issued under this Section shall 10 11 expire according to the staggered multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code. 12

The design, color, and format of the plates shall be 13 (b) wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State, 14 15 except that the U.S. Marine Corps emblem shall appear on the 16 plates. The Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be issued as vanity or personalized plates in 17 accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are 18 19 not required to designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary 20 21 shall prescribe the eligibility requirements and, in his or 22 her discretion, shall approve and prescribe stickers or 23 decals as provided under Section 3-412.

(c) An applicant shall be charged a \$20 fee for original 24 25 issuance in addition to the applicable registration fee. Of this additional fee, \$15 shall be deposited into the 26 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund and \$5 shall be 27 deposited into the Marine Corps Scholarship Fund. For each 28 registration renewal period, a \$20 fee, in addition to the 29 30 appropriate registration fee, shall be charged. Of this additional fee, \$2 shall be deposited into the Secretary of 31 32 State Special License Plate Fund and \$18 shall be deposited 33 into the Marine Corps Scholarship Fund.

(d) The Marine Corps Scholarship Fund is created as a

1 special fund in the State treasury. All moneys in the Marine 2 Corps Scholarship Fund shall, subject to appropriation by the General Assembly and approval by the Secretary, be used by 3 4 the Marine Corps Scholarship Foundation, Inc., a recognized 5 charitable organization that meets the requirements of Title б 26, Section 501(c)(3) of the United States Code, to provide 7 grants for scholarships for higher education. The scholarship recipients must be the children of current or former members 8 9 of the United States Marine Corps who meet the academic, financial, and other requirements established by the Marine 10 11 Corps Scholarship Foundation. In addition, the recipients must be Illinois residents and must attend a college or 12 university located within the State of Illinois. 13

The State Treasurer shall require the Marine Corps 14 15 Scholarship Foundation to establish a separate account for 16 receipt of the proceeds of the Marine Corps Scholarship Fund. That account shall be subject to audit either annually or at 17 another interval, as determined by the State Treasurer. 18 19 Proceeds from the Marine Corps Scholarship Fund shall be transferred on a quarterly basis by the State Treasurer's 20 21 office to this separate account.

7 Commencing with the 2001 registration year and extending 8 through the 2003 registration year, the registration fee paid 9 by any vehicle owner who has claimed and received a grant under the "Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons Property Tax 10 Relief and Pharmaceutical Assistance Act or who is the 11 spouse of such a person shall be \$24 instead of the fee 12 otherwise provided in this Code for passenger cars displaying 13 standard multi-year registration plates issued under Section 14 15 3-414.1, motor vehicles displaying special registration 16 plates issued under Section 3-616, motor vehicles registered 8,000 pounds or less under Section 3-815(a) and 17 at recreational vehicles registered at 8,000 pounds or 18 less under Section 3-815(b). Widows and widowers of claimants 19 shall also be entitled to this reduced registration fee for 20 21 the registration year in which the claimant was eligible.

22 Commencing with the 2004 registration year, the 23 registration fee paid by any vehicle owner who has claimed 24 and received a grant under the Senior Citizens and Disabled 25 Persons Property Tax Relief and Pharmaceutical Assistance Act or who is the spouse of such a person shall be \$24 instead of 26 27 the fee otherwise provided in this Code for passenger cars displaying standard multi-year registration plates issued 28 under Section 3-414.1, motor vehicles displaying special 29 registration plates issued under Section 3-616, 3-623, 3-624, 30 31 <u>3-625, 3-626, 3-628, 3-638, 3-642, 3-645, 3-647, 3-650, or</u> 3-651, motor vehicles registered at 8,000 pounds or less 32 33 under Section 3-815(a), and recreational vehicles registered at 8,000 pounds or less under Section 3-815(b). Widows and 34

2 registration fee for the registration year in which the

4 No more than one reduced registration fee under this 5 Section shall be allowed during any 12 month period based on the primary eligibility of any individual, whether such б 7 reduced registration fee is allowed to the individual or to the spouse, widow or widower of such individual. This 8 9 Section does not apply to the fee paid in addition to the 10 registration fee for motor vehicles displaying vanity or special personalized license plates under-Section-3-806.1. 11
