- 7 (625 ILCS 5/1-117.7 new)
- 8 Sec. 1-117.7. Electric personal assistive mobility
- 9 <u>device</u>. A self-balancing 2 non-tandem wheeled device
- 10 <u>designed to transport only one person with an electric</u>
- 11 propulsion system with average power of 750 watts (one
- 12 <u>horsepower</u>), whose maximum speed on a paved level surface,
- when powered solely by a propulsion system of that type while
- 14 ridden by an operator weighing 170 pounds, is less than 20
- miles per hour.
- 16 (625 ILCS 5/11-1412.1) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 11-1412.1)
- 17 Sec. 11-1412.1. Driving upon sidewalk. No person shall
- 18 drive any vehicle upon a sidewalk or sidewalk area except
- 19 upon a permanent or duly authorized temporary driveway. This
- 20 Section does not apply to any vehicle moved exclusively by
- 21 human power, to any electric personal assistive mobility
- 22 <u>device,</u> nor to any motorized wheelchair.
