Failure to pay fines, charges, and costs on an abandoned vehicle. 8 (a) Whenever any resident of this State fails to pay any 9 fine, charge, or cost imposed for a violation of Section 10 4-201 of this Code, or a similar provision of a local 11 ordinance, the clerk may notify the Secretary of State, on a 12 report prescribed by the Secretary, and the Secretary shall 13 14 prohibit the renewal, reissue, or reinstatement of the resident's driving privileges until the fine, charge, or cost 15 has been paid in full. The clerk shall provide notice to the 16 driver, at the driver's last known address as shown on the 17 court's records, stating that the action will be effective on 18 the 46th day following the date of the above notice if 19 payment is not received in full by the court of venue. 20 21 (b) Following receipt of the report from the clerk, the

22 Secretary of State shall make the proper notation to the

driver's file to prohibit the renewal, reissue, or 1 2 reinstatement of the driver's driving privileges. Except as provided in subsection (d) of this Section, the notation 3 4 shall not be removed from the driver's record until the driver satisfies the outstanding fine, charge, or cost and an 5 6 appropriate notice on a form prescribed by the Secretary is received by the Secretary from the court of venue, stating 7 8 that the fine, charge, or cost has been paid in full. Upon 9 payment in full of a fine, charge, or court cost which has previously been reported under this Section as unpaid, the 10 clerk of the court shall present the driver with a signed 11 receipt containing the seal of the court indicating that the 12 fine, charge, or cost has been paid in full, and shall 13 forward immediately to the Secretary of State a notice 14 15 stating that the fine, charge, or cost has been paid in full. (c) Notwithstanding the receipt of a report from the 16 clerk as prescribed in subsection (a), nothing in this 17 Section is intended to place any responsibility upon the 18 19 Secretary of State to provide independent notice to the driver of any potential action to disallow the renewal, 20 reissue, or reinstatement of the driver's driving privileges. 21 (d) The Secretary of State shall renew, reissue, or 22 23 reinstate a driver's driving privileges which were previously refused under this Section upon presentation of an original 24 receipt which is signed by the clerk of the court and 25 contains the seal of the court indicating that the fine, 26 charge, or cost has been paid in full. The Secretary of 27 State shall retain the receipt for his or her records. 28
