AN ACT concerning nursing home facilities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Nursing Home Care Act is amended by
changing Section 3-310 as follows:

7 Sec. 3-310. <u>Penalties; Long Term Care Education Fund.</u>

8 (a) All penalties shall be paid to the Department within 10 days of receipt of notice of assessment or, if the penalty 9 is contested under Section 3-309, within 10 days of receipt 10 of the final decision, unless the decision is appealed and 11 the order is stayed by court order under Section 3-713. A 12 13 penalty assessed under this Act shall be collected by the Department and shall be deposited with the State Treasurer 14 15 into the Long Term Care Education Monitor/Receiver Fund, 16 which is hereby created as a special fund in the State Treasury. Moneys in the Fund shall be used, pursuant to 17 appropriations, only for the purpose provided in this 18 19 Section.

If the person or facility against whom a penalty has been assessed does not comply with a written demand for payment within 30 days, the Director shall issue an order to do any of the following:

(1) direct the State Treasurer to deduct the amount
of the fine from amounts otherwise due from the State for
the penalty and remit that amount to the Department;

(2) add the amount of the penalty to the facility's
licensing fee; if the licensee refuses to make the
payment at the time of application for renewal of its
license, the license shall not be renewed; or

31 (3) bring an action in circuit court to recover the

1	amount of the penalty.
2	(b) The Department must use any monetary penalties
3	received from assessments against nursing homes for (i)
4	quality care initiatives or (ii) nursing home staff education
5	and training.
