- 8 <u>Sec. 1405-35. Nursing home risk management practices.</u>
- 9 <u>(a) The Director shall adopt and promulgate best</u>
- 10 practices guidelines for risk management and loss control for
- nursing homes no later than April 30, 2003.
- 12 (b) In developing the best practices guidelines, the
- 13 <u>Director shall appoint and consult with a task force composed</u>
- 14 <u>of:</u>
- 15 <u>(1) the Director or the Director's designee of the</u>
- 16 <u>Department of Public Aid and of the Department of Public</u>
- 17 <u>Health;</u>
- 18 <u>(2) five representatives of insurance companies</u>
- that write liability insurance for nursing homes; and
