- 8 (a) It is unlawful for any person to willfully cause or
- 9 permit the life or health of a child under the age of 18 to

- 11 placed in circumstances that endanger the child's life or
- 12 health.
- 13 <u>(a-5) A person commits the offense of endangering the</u>
- 14 <u>life or health of a child if he or she leaves a child</u>
- 15 <u>unattended in a motor vehicle.</u> For purposes of this
- 16 <u>subsection:</u>
- 17 (1) There is a rebuttable presumption that a person
- 18 <u>committed the offense if he or she left a child</u>
- 19 <u>unattended in a motor vehicle for more than 10 minutes.</u>
- 20 (2) "Unattended" means either: (i) not accompanied
- 21 <u>by a person 14 years of age or older; or (ii) if</u>
