- 4 Section 5. The Firearm Owners Identification Card Act is
- 5 amended by adding Section 8.5 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 8.5. Department to conduct ongoing criminal history
- 8 <u>checks</u>.
- 9 (a) The Department shall, for every person to whom a
- 10 Firearm Owner's Identification Card is issued, inquire
- 11 through the Law Enforcement Agencies Data System (LEADS) to
- 12 <u>ascertain whether or not the person has been convicted of any</u>
- of the offenses enumerated in Section 8 of this Act that
- 14 <u>would disqualify him or her from holding a Firearm Owner's</u>
- 15 <u>Identification Card. This inquiry shall be done on an</u>
- ongoing basis as determined by the Director but not less than
- 17 <u>once every 6 months. If the inquiry reveals that the person</u>
