This inquiry shall be done on an 16 ongoing basis as determined by the Director but not less than 17 once every 6 months. If the inquiry reveals that the person 18 has been convicted of any of the disqualifying offenses 19 enumerated in Section 8 of this Act, the Department shall 20 21 immediately send written notice to the person as required by 22 Section 9 of this Act and revoke the person's card.

1 (b) The Department shall pursue the feasibility of 2 conducting ongoing and periodic background checks of 3 appropriate national data systems via the National Instant 4 Criminal Background Check System.
