Driver education course. Any school

minutes of classroom instruction relating to organ and tissue donation and organ and tissue donation procedures. No student shall be required to participate in this instruction if his or her parent or guardian files written objection thereto on constitutional grounds, and refusal to participate in this instruction on those grounds shall not be reason for suspension or expulsion of a student or result in any academic penalty.
