- 7 <u>Sec. 12-10.5. Medicaid Buy-In Program Revolving Fund.</u>
- 8 <u>(a) The Medicaid Buy-In Program Revolving Fund is</u>
- 9 <u>created</u>. The Fund shall be held by the Department of Public
- 10 Aid. The Fund shall consist of all moneys received by the
- 11 Department in connection with the implementation of the
- 12 <u>Medicaid Buy-In Program established under paragraph 11 of</u>
- 13 <u>Section 5-2 of this Code</u>. <u>Those moneys include the</u>
- 14 <u>following:</u>
- 15 (1) Payments of buy-in premiums by individuals.
- 16 (2) Payments by insurance companies.
- 17 (3) Receipts from federal financial participation

- 20 (b) The Department shall use the moneys in the Fund to
