13	the duties of the office, a person must possess one of the
14	following qualifications as certified by the individual to

16	(1) a Certified Illinois Assessing Officer
17	certificate from the Illinois Property Assessment
18	<u>Institute; or</u>
19	(2) a Certified Assessment Evaluator designation

from the International Association of Assessing Officers.

<u>In addition</u> elected-as-county-assessor, a person must have at

least 2 years experience in the field of property sales,

- 1 assessments, finance, or appraisals.
- 2 The county clerk must determine if candidates for
- 3 assessor have qualified under this Code prior to
- 4 certification of their nominating petitions. The election of
- 5 the county assessor shall be at the same time and in the same
- 6 manner as other county officials are elected under the
- 7 general election law. The county assessor shall hold office
- 8 for a 4 year term and until a successor is elected and
- 9 qualified. Vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as
- 10 are vacancies in other county elective offices.
