- 7 Sec. 13B-40. Grievance procedure. Any person aggrieved
- 8 by a decision regarding the failure of an emissions test or

- 11 with the Agency within 30 days after the decision was made,
- 12 and the Agency shall thereupon investigate the matter. Within
