- 4 Section 5. The Office of Banks and Real Estate Act is
- 5 amended by adding Section 5.5 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 3205/5.5 new)
- 7 Sec. 5.5. Payment by credit card or third-party payment
- 8 <u>agent</u>.
- 9 (a) For the purposes of this Section, the term "credit
- 10 <u>card</u>" has the meaning given in Section 10 of the Local
- 11 Governmental Acceptance of Credit Cards Act.
- 12 (b) The Office may, but need not, accept payment by
- 13 <u>credit card for any fee, fine, or other charge that it is</u>
- 14 <u>authorized by law to collect. The Office may adopt rules and</u>
- 15 procedures governing the acceptance of payment by credit card
- 16 and may enter into such agreements as may be necessary to
- 17 <u>accept payment by credit card.</u>
- 18 (c) The Office may enter into agreements with one or
- 19 more financial institutions, internet companies, or other
- 20 <u>business entities to act as third-party payment agents for</u>
- 21 the payment of fees, fines, or other charges to the Office.
- 22 <u>These agreements may authorize the third-party payment agent</u>
- 23 <u>to retain a service fee out of the payments collected.</u>
- 24 The Office may, but need not, accept payment through a
- 25 <u>third-party payment agent of any fee, fine, or other charge</u>
- 26 that it is authorized by law to collect. The Office may
- 27 <u>adopt rules and procedures governing the acceptance of</u>
- 28 payments through third-party payment agents.
- 29 (d) Receipt by the Office of the amount of a fee, fine,
- 30 <u>or other charge paid by credit card or through a third-party</u>
- 31 payment agent authorized by the Office, less the amount of

- 1 any service fee retained under the Office's agreement with
- 2 the credit card service provider or third-party payment
- 3 agent, shall be deemed receipt of the full amount of the fee
- 4 or other charge and shall discharge the payment obligation in
- 5 <u>full.</u>
- 6 (e) In the event of a conflict between this Section and
- 7 <u>a provision of any other Act administered by the Office, this</u>
- 8 <u>Section controls.</u>
- 9 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 10 becoming law.
