AN ACT concerning higher education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Higher Education Student Assistance Act
is amended by changing Section 45 as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 947/45)

7 Sec. 45. Illinois National Guard grant program.

(a) As used in this Section:

"State controlled university or community college" means 9 those institutions under the administration of the Chicago 10 State University Board of Trustees, the Eastern Illinois 11 University Board of Trustees, the Governors State University 12 13 Board of Trustees, the Illinois State University Board of Trustees, the Northeastern Illinois University Board of 14 15 Trustees, the Northern Illinois University Board of Trustees, 16 the Western Illinois University Board of Trustees, Southern Illinois University Board of Trustees, University of Illinois 17 18 Board of Trustees, or the Illinois Community College Board.

19 "Tuition and fees" shall not include expenses for any 20 sectarian or denominational instruction, the construction or 21 maintenance of sectarian or denominational facilities, or any 22 other sectarian or denominational purposes or activity.

"Fees" means matriculation, graduation, activity, term, 23 or incidental fees. Exemption shall not be granted from any 24 other fees, including book rental, service, laboratory, 25 26 supply, and union building fees, hospital and medical 27 insurance fees, and any fees established for the operation and maintenance of buildings, the income of which is pledged 28 to the payment of interest and principal on bonds issued by 29 the governing board of any university or community college. 30 31 (b) Any enlisted person or any company grade officer,

1 including warrant officers, First and Second Lieutenants, and 2 Captains in the Army and Air National Guard, who has served least one year in the Illinois National Guard and who 3 at. 4 possesses all necessary entrance requirements shall, upon 5 application and proper proof, be awarded a grant to the 6 State-controlled university or community college of his or 7 her choice, consisting of exemption from tuition and fees for 8 not more than the equivalent of 4 years of full-time 9 enrollment in relation to his or her course of study at that State controlled university or community college while he 10 or 11 she is a member of the Illinois National Guard. If the recipient of any grant awarded under this Section ceases to 12 be a member of the Illinois National Guard while enrolled in 13 a course of study under that grant, the grant shall be 14 terminated as of the date membership in the Illinois National 15 16 Guard ended, and the recipient shall be permitted to complete the school term in which he or she is then enrolled only upon 17 payment of tuition and other fees allocable to the part of 18 19 the term then remaining. If the recipient of the grant fails to complete his or her military service obligations or 20 requirements for satisfactory participation, the Department 21 22 of Military Affairs shall require the recipient to repay the 23 amount of the grant received, prorated according to the fraction of the service obligation not completed, and, if 24 25 applicable, reasonable collection fees. The Department of 26 Military Affairs may adopt rules relating to its collection activities for repayment of the grant under this Section. 27 Unsatisfactory participation shall be defined by rules 28 adopted by the Department of Military Affairs. Repayments 29 30 shall be deposited in the National Guard Grant Fund. The 31 National Guard Grant Fund is created as a special fund in the 32 State treasury. All money in the National Guard Grant Fund 33 shall be used, subject to appropriation, by the Department of 34 Military Affairs for the purposes of this Section.

A grant awarded under this Section shall be considered an entitlement which the State-controlled university or community college in which the holder is enrolled shall honor without any condition other than the holder's maintenance of minimum grade levels and a satisfactory student loan repayment record pursuant to subsection (c) of Section 20 of this Act.

8 (c) Subject to a separate appropriation for such 9 purposes, the Commission may reimburse the State-controlled 10 university or community college for grants authorized by this 11 Section.
