AN ACT concerning public employee benefits.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by changing Section 6-217 as follows:

(40 ILCS 5/6-217) (from Ch. 108 1/2, par. 6-217)

Sec. 6-217. Age stated in employment application to be conclusive.

For any fireman, as defined in this Article, who has filed an application for appointment as a member of the fire department of the city, the age therein stated shall be conclusive evidence of his age for the purposes of <u>providing</u> <u>all benefits under</u> this Article. <u>However, for any fireman, as</u> <u>defined in this Article, entering service with the City of</u> <u>Chicago Fire Department after January 1, 2020, the actual</u> <u>birthdate as provided in the fireman's birth certificate shall</u> <u>be conclusive evidence of the fireman's age for the purposes of</u> <u>this Article.</u>
