

AN ACT concerning taxes.

**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
represented in the General Assembly:**

Section 5. The Mobile Home Local Services Tax Enforcement Act is amended by changing Section 60 as follows:

(35 ILCS 516/60)

Sec. 60. Times of publication of notice. The advertisement shall be published once at least 10 days before the day on which judgment is to be applied for, and shall contain a list of the delinquent mobile homes upon which the taxes or any part thereof remain due and unpaid, the names of owners, ~~and~~ the street and the, common address, ~~and mobile home park~~ where the mobile home is sited, if known, the vehicle identification number, if known, ~~the model year of the home, the square footage of the home,~~ the total amount due, and the year or years for which they are due. In counties of less than 3,000,000 inhabitants, advertisement shall include notice of the registration requirement for persons bidding at the sale.

The collector shall give notice that he or she will apply to the circuit court on a specified day for judgment against the mobile homes for the taxes, and costs, and for an order to sell the mobile homes for the satisfaction of the amount due.

The collector shall also give notice of a date within the next 5 business days after the date of application on which all the mobile homes for the sale of which an order is made will be exposed to public sale at a location within the county designated by the county collector, for the amount of taxes and cost due. The advertisement published according to the provisions of this Section shall be deemed to be sufficient notice of the intended application for judgment and of the sale of mobile homes under the order of the court.
