

AN ACT concerning government.

**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
represented in the General Assembly:**

Section 5. The State Commemorative Dates Act is amended by changing Section 90 as follows:

(5 ILCS 490/90) (from Ch. 1, par. 3051-90)

Sec. 90. Veterans Day. The eleventh day of November of each year shall be a holiday to be known as Veterans Day and to be observed throughout the State as a day to hold appropriate exercises in commemoration of the victory of the United States Army, the United States Navy, ~~and~~ the United States Air Force, the United States Marines, the United States Coast Guard, and the United States Merchant Marines in all wars.
