Please find the attached documents to fulfill the basic requirements of the Law Enforcement Camera Grant Act (50 ILCS 707/15). Due to a lack of manpower and other resources, I was unable to provide a complete list for item (4) from the Grant Act, however, the attached information provides information for each camera (2) received from the Grant. The in-car cameras begin recording automatically when the squad car emergency lights are activated for any reason, including responding to various emergency calls that do not involve an arrest or citation. The sheer volume of events recorded daily/weekly/monthly present a problem for collecting and monitoring specific data from each in-car camera, without manpower utilized exclusively for that function.

Supervisors at the Lebanon Police Department complete periodic reviews of in-car video as needed, for the following reasons:

- To investigate complaints and/or compliments from citizens.
- To review officer's response to critical incidents.
- As a training aid for in-service departmental training.
- As a case review when in-car video is submitted as evidence to aid prosecuting State or Federal cases.
- As a function check to verify the camera system is operating correctly.
- On a case-by-case basis as determined by a supervisor.

I have also attached documents with total incidents handled by the Lebanon Police Department during this time. This would include total citations/arrests completed by the Lebanon Police Department from January 1st, 2020 thru December 31st, 2020. The Lebanon Police Department put (2) cameras that were purchased through the Camera Grant Program into service in approximately early August 2018. However, as stated in my memo dated May 1, 2019 our camera equipment did not become functionable until approximately mid 2019 because of unanticipated cost.

Please contact me if clarification or further explanation is needed regarding the attached information.

The Lebanon Police Department applied for and received the 2018 camera grant from the Illinois Training and Standards Board on or around 5/3/2018 (SAIN1669-6136). This award consisted of (2) cameras that were purchased from CDS Office Technologies on 6/29/2018. The equipment related to this purchased were installed by both Solve Your System, Inc. and The True-line Group, Inc. In accordance with the summary report required on or before May 1, 2019 and per my conversation yesterday with John here is all the information I have:

1. The Lebanon Police Department received (2) cameras from the grant.
2. The Lebanon Police Department installed (2) cameras in squad cars L1 – L2.
L1- Panasonic Arbitrator 360 HD #RFA00127
L2- Panasonic Arbitrator 360 HD #RFA00302
3. The supervisors will review videos from their respective officers. Any policy or training issues discovered will be documented and forwarded to me.
4. The Lebanon Police Department has no recordings documented from the cameras since there installation. This is because of technical difficulties with connecting the server to the in-car cameras and cost involved. So therefore, LPD has no additional information for this requirement. This issue connecting the two should be resolved shortly.
5. No further information relevant.
