

This report is being submitted by the Department of Children and Family Services pursuant to the Children and Family Services Act, 20 ILCS 505/5.46(i). That section of the Act directs the Department to file a report with the General Assembly providing the following information for State Fiscal Years 2019, 2020, 2021, and 2022 and annually beginning February 28, 2023, for the preceding fiscal year:

- (1) The number of youth entering care.
- (2) The number of youth entering care receiving each of the following types of benefits: Social Security benefits, Supplemental Security Income, Veterans benefits, Railroad Retirement benefits.
- (3) The number of youth entering care for whom the Department filed an application for each of the following types of benefits: Social Security benefits, Supplemental Security Income, Veterans benefits, Railroad Retirement benefits.
- (4) The number of youth entering care who were awarded each of the following types of benefits based on an application filed by the Department: Social Security benefits, Supplemental Security Income, Veterans benefits, Railroad Retirement benefits.

The attached document includes the above required information, with the exception of items (2), (3) & (4) specifically for the State Fiscal Year 2019. That data was not available to the Department to report based on the prior vendor records. Beginning in State Fiscal Year 2020, a new vendor was selected and the requested records were available and are included in this report.
