The trainee will be assigned to Divisions under the Chief Deputy Director of Product Lines to enhance experience in basic processing procedures, terminology, and techniques to become familiar with interrelationships among Agency operating areas. Utilizes Spanish speaking, reading, and writing skills in interacting with and assisting Spanish speaking insurance company representatives, licensees and consumers with insurance-related inquiries and complaints and provides translation and interpretation for staff of other areas of the Department.
