Re: Data Governance and Organization to Support Equity and Racial Justice Act Section 20-15(a) Report

This report is issued pursuant to the provisions of Section 20-15(a) of the Data Governance and Organization to Support Equity and Racial Justice Act ("the Act") (20 ILCS 65/20-1). The Act requires the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) to report statistical data on the racial, ethnic, age, sex, disability status, sexual orientation, gender identity, and primary or preferred language demographics of program participants for each major program the Illinois Department of Public Health administers.

Introduction

In the first Annual March Data Governance and Organization to Support Equity and Racial Justice Act Report, the Illinois Department of Public Health identified the following "major programs" and corresponding participant populations for analysis:

- 1. Health Promotion Genetics Counseling
- 2. Health Promotion Illinois Tobacco Quit Line
- 3. Health Protection Illinois Lead Program
- 4. Minority Health COVID-19 Community-Based Testing and Intervention Targeting Minority Populations
- 5. Minority Health-Communities of Color Special At Risk Population 2023
- 6. Minority Health COVID-19 Migrant Workers Mobile Testing and Outbreak Response
- 7. Women's Health Family Planning
- 8. Women's Health Illinois Breast and Cervical Cancer Program
- 9. Women's Health Illinois WISEWOMAN Program
- 10. Women's Health University of Illinois at Chicago Division of Specialized Care for Children

For each major program identified in the Illinois Department of Public Health March 2022 report, this report will provide statistical data were available for each of demographic dispositions enumerated in the Act: race, age, sex, disability status, sexual orientation, gender identity and primary or preferred language.



The information contained in this report is based solely on the data provided by program participants and collected by programming personnel for the various major FY23 programs awarded over \$1M. For the purpose of this report, program participants are defined as any individual who receives program services or interventions directly from state agency staff, contractors, or grantees. The program participants count is the number of distinct individuals who have been identified as program participants regardless of demographic category. The information is submitted electronically into the grant management system.

Methodology

The information contained in this report is based solely on the data provided by program participants and collected by programming personnel for the major programs. The data provided by program participants has not been audited for completeness and quality, therefore, no baseline for comparison has been established.

For the purpose of this report, program participants are defined as *any individual who receives program services or interventions directly from state agency staff, contractors, or grantees.* The program participants count is the number of distinct individuals that have been identified as program participants regardless of demographic category.

General Methodology

Based on the guidance provided, the major programs were identified in the Department's Electronic Grants Administration and Management System (EGrAMS) and after a discussion with the respective IDPH grant administrators, 10 programs were identified for the Equity Racial Justice Act (ERJA) data collection and reporting for the Fiscal Year 2023.

Based on the programs identified for the FY-2023 ERJA Reporting, the ERJA Reporting was set up in EGrAMS under the following 8 categories:

- Race
- 2. Ethnicity
- 3. Age
- 4. Sex
- 5. Disability Status
- 6. Sexual Orientation
- 7. Gender Identity
- 8. Primary or Preferred Language

The IDPH Office of Performance Management (OPM) presented the ERJA data collection to the respective IDPH grant administrators and conducted a training to the respective grantees. The ERJA reports automatically appear in the grantee reporting queue and the information for the above 8 categories was entered and submitted by the grantees.



Based on the ERJA information submitted by grantees, the data was aggregated at a program level for the above 8 categories. For the Communities of Color Special At Risk Population program (COCSP), 'Event Type' and number of 'Test Administered' was also set up in EGrAMS as a monthly data collection metrics. For COCSP in addition to the above 8 categories, the 'Event Type' and number of 'Test Administered' was aggregated by the various Event Types and Types of Tests Administered.

Race and Ethnicity

The Act provides that Illinois Department of Public Health "shall use the same racial and ethnic classifications for each program." 20 ILCS 65/20-15(a). The enumerated classifications are:

- (1) American Indian and Alaska Native alone.
- (2) Asian alone.
- (3) Black or African American alone.
- (4) Hispanic or Latino of any race.
- (5) Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander alone.
- (6) White alone.
- (7) Some other race alone.
- (8) Two or more races.

Id. The Act further allows for Illinois Department of Public Health to "further define the racial and ethnic categories[.]" *Id. Provide a narrative explaining if the agency currently uses additional racial and ethnic categories.*

[Act further States that if

a program administered by the Board, or the Department is subject to federal reporting requirements that include the collection and public reporting of statistical data on the racial and ethnic demographics of program participants, the Department may maintain the same racial and ethnic classifications used under the federal requirements if such classifications differ from the classifications listed in subsection (a).

As Illinois Department of Public Health is required to comply with federal reporting requirements for its major grant programs, the Department has provided information relating to the following categories in **Appendix A** of this report.



Appendix A Key:

- "X" is used to indicate when a demographic disposition has 10 or fewer people.
- "0" " is used to indicate that data for a demographic disposition is collected, but no program participants have selected that category as of when the report was pulled.
- A blank space is used to indicate that data for a demographic disposition is not collected
