# 2023 ANNUAL CANNABIS REPORT

Illinois Department of Public Health







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## **SUMMARY**

The Medical Cannabis and Opioid Alternative programs, overseen by the Illinois Department of Public Health, assist the most vulnerable citizens suffering debilitating medical conditions to receive support and access to cannabis for medical use and pain relief.

During FY23, the IDPH Division of Medical Cannabis experienced increases in the number of patients served and in the number of registered providers. As in the previous year, the division performed public outreach and training to increase awareness of the Medical Cannabis programs and to support the local health departments that aid patients applying for participation in the programs.

# Overview of the Medical Cannabis Patient Program and Opioid Alternative Pilot Program

In August 2013, Illinois became the 20th state to authorize a program for the cultivation and dispensing of cannabis for medical purposes. The statewide Medical Cannabis Patient Registry Program (MCPP) allows patients diagnosed with a qualifying condition to access medical cannabis. The Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) manages the registry by receiving and processing applications and issuing registry cards to Illinois residents meeting program requirements. Application resources, new and existing patient instructions, health care providers, contact information, laws, rules, and referral sources are available online (Medical Cannabis Patient Registry Program (illinois.gov)).


In August 2018, Public Act 100-1114, the <u>Alternative to Opioids Act of 2018</u>, was signed making changes to the Compassionate Use of Medical Cannabis Pilot Program Act. The public act created the Opioid Alternative Pilot Program (OAPP), which allows access to medical cannabis for individuals who have a prescription for opioids or have a condition for which an opioid otherwise would be prescribed, as certified to by a registered health care provider.

On January 31, 2019, IDPH officially launched the OAPP. Qualifying patients for OAPP must be at least 21 years old and be a resident of Illinois. Licensed physicians must certify the qualifying patients have a medical condition for which an opioid has been or could be prescribed based on generally accepted standards of care. Requirements, laws and rules for qualifying patients, and resources for physicians are detailed on the website (Opioid Alternative Pilot Program [illinois.gov]). The long-term goal of the program is to reduce harm related to opioid use.

#### 1. Number of applications and renewals filed for registry identification cards/registrations.

- IDPH has approved 237,440 applications for qualifying patients since it began accepting applications for MCPP on September 2, 2014.
- The number of active patients in the MCPP program as of June 30, 2023 was 138,471.
- 24,810 applications were renewed in FY23.
- The highest percentage of qualifying applications were submitted by individuals between 31 and 40 years of age.
- Among registered MCPP patients in FY23, a higher percentage reported a gender of male than female (53.09% vs. 45.58%).





#### 2. Number of qualifying patients and designated caregivers served by each dispensary for 2022.

On July 15, 2021, Gov. JB Pritzker signed HB1443, which removed the requirement of a medical cannabis patient and/or caregiver to select a single dispensary.

#### 3. Nature of the debilitating medical conditions of the qualifying patients.

The top five debilitating medical conditions from qualifying patients for FY23 (Table1) remain unchanged from the prior year and are:

- 1. Chronic pain
- 2. Post-traumatic stress disorder
- 3. Migraines
- 4. Osteoarthritis
- 5. Severe fibromyalgia

#### 4. The number of registry identification cards or registrations revoked for misconduct.

- 85 MCPP patient and designated caregiver registry identification cards were revoked.
- Major credential status reasons for revoking included death, change from terminal illness to qualifying patient, reapplication with new qualifying patient, and IDPH physician revocation.

# 5. The number of certifying health care professionals providing written certifications for qualifying patients.

• 4,990 health care professionals provided written certifications for qualifying patients.


# 6. The number of registered medical cannabis cultivation centers or registered dispensing organizations.

- The number of medical cannabis cultivation centers in FY23 was 21 and was unchanged from the prior year. (See Appendix A)
- There are 55 licensed medical cannabis dispensaries. (See Appendix B)

#### 7. The number of Opioid Alternative Pilot Program participants.

- 1,564 patients were enrolled in the OAPP, continuing a trend of growth in participation in this program since FY21.
- 54% of OAPP participants were prescribed an opioid.
