SUBJECT: Data Governance and Organization to Support Equity and Racial Justice Act Section 20-15(a) Report

This report is issued pursuant to the provisions of Section 20-15(a) of the Data Governance and Organization to Support Equity and Racial Justice Act ("the Act") (20 ILCS 65/20-1). The Act requires Illinois Department of Transportation ("IDOT" or "the Department") to report statistical data on the racial, ethnic, age, sex, disability status, sexual orientation, gender identity, and primary or preferred language demographics of program participants for each major program the Illinois Department of Transportation administers.

#### Introduction

In the first Annual March Data Governance and Organization to Support Equity and Racial Justice Act Report, Illinois Department of Transportation identified the following "major programs" and corresponding participant populations for analysis:

- Cycle Rider Safety Training Program
- No new programs added

For each major program identified in the Illinois Department of Transportation's March 2024 report, this report will provide statistical data where available for each of demographic dispositions enumerated in the Act: race, age, sex, disability status, sexual orientation, gender identity and primary or preferred language.

Section 20-15(e) of the Act states "if the Board or Department is unable to begin reporting the data required by subsection (a) by July 1, 2022, the Board or the Department shall state the reasons for the delay under the reporting requirements.

IDOT is unable to report on the aforementioned data for two of the three training regions in Illinois (Region A and B) due to lack of data collection during student registration. This data has not been collected and therefore cannot be reported on.

## **Change Management Efforts and Potential Challenges**

The Southern Illinois University training facility in Region C has been using the Rider Education Management System (REMS). This application has allowed IDOT to collect the necessary demographics to be fully compliant with ERJA

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within Region C. Moving forward in calendar year 2024, effective June 1, 2024, REMS will be used to collect the data in all three training regions.

### Methodology

The information contained in this report is based solely on the data reported to the provided by program participants and collected by programming personal for the various major programs. The data provided by program participants has not been audited for completeness and quality, therefore, no baseline for comparison has been established.

For the purpose of this report, IDOT has further defined "program participants" as cycle rider safety students who have registered for a Cycle Rider Safety Training Program course at a Regional Center.

The program participants count is the number of distinct individuals that have been identified as program participants regardless of demographic category.

#### Race and Ethnicity

The Act provides that Illinois Department of Transportation "shall use the same racial and ethnic classifications for each program." 20 ILCS 65/20-15(a). The enumerated classifications are:

- (1) American Indian and Alaska Native alone.
- (2) Asian alone.
- (3) Black or African American alone.
- (4) Hispanic or Latino of any race.
- (5) Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander alone.
- (6) White alone.
- (7) Some other race alone.
- (8) Two or more races.

As the Illinois Department of Transportation is required to comply with federal reporting requirements for its Cycle Rider Safety Training Program the Department has provided information relating to the following categories in its report.

- Race
- Ethnicity
- Age
- Sex
- Disability Status
- Sexual orientation
- Gender Identity
- Primary or preferred language

#### **Statistical Data**

The Department has implemented finalizing the new data collection system (REMS) that captures all data fields based on the previously provided ERJA worksheet. In 2023, this information was captured for the training facility at Southern Illinois University at Carbondale. Beginning June 1, 2024, all regional training centers will be capturing all the required data fields.

### The Illinois Department of Transportation's Cycle Rider Safety Training Program

Data was collected from the Department's Southern Illinois University Regional Training facility from March 1, 2023, to December 1, 2023 with 2,412 total program participants; no training occurred between December 2, 2023 and February 29, 2024. This data was pulled on June 11, 2024.
